WAI'ANAE HAWAIIAN CIVIC CLUB SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATIONS GUIDELINE

ELIGIBILITY:

- Must be accepted into a college, university or training program.
- Must have a GPA of 2.5 or better
- Preference to those of Hawaiian ancestry

A scholarship in the amount of \$500 for the academic school year **2021** will be paid directly to the school for the recipient's tuition costs.

REQUIREMENTS:

The items listed below must be submitted <u>before</u> your application will be considered:

- Completed WHCC application form.
- One (1) Letter of Reference
- High school or college transcripts
- Evidence of admission to a school or college
- Letter of Admission to a University, College or Training School.
- Type essay of 500 words or more. Essay on Educational plans, Career goals, How you will contribute to the Native Hawaiian Community and your family background

Recipients can only receive only **one** award each academic year. If awarded a scholarship, recipient will become member for year 2022(funded by the scholarship committee) will participate at least one (1) event with the WHCC for 2022.
